





2024 New Hudl Game Film – main page

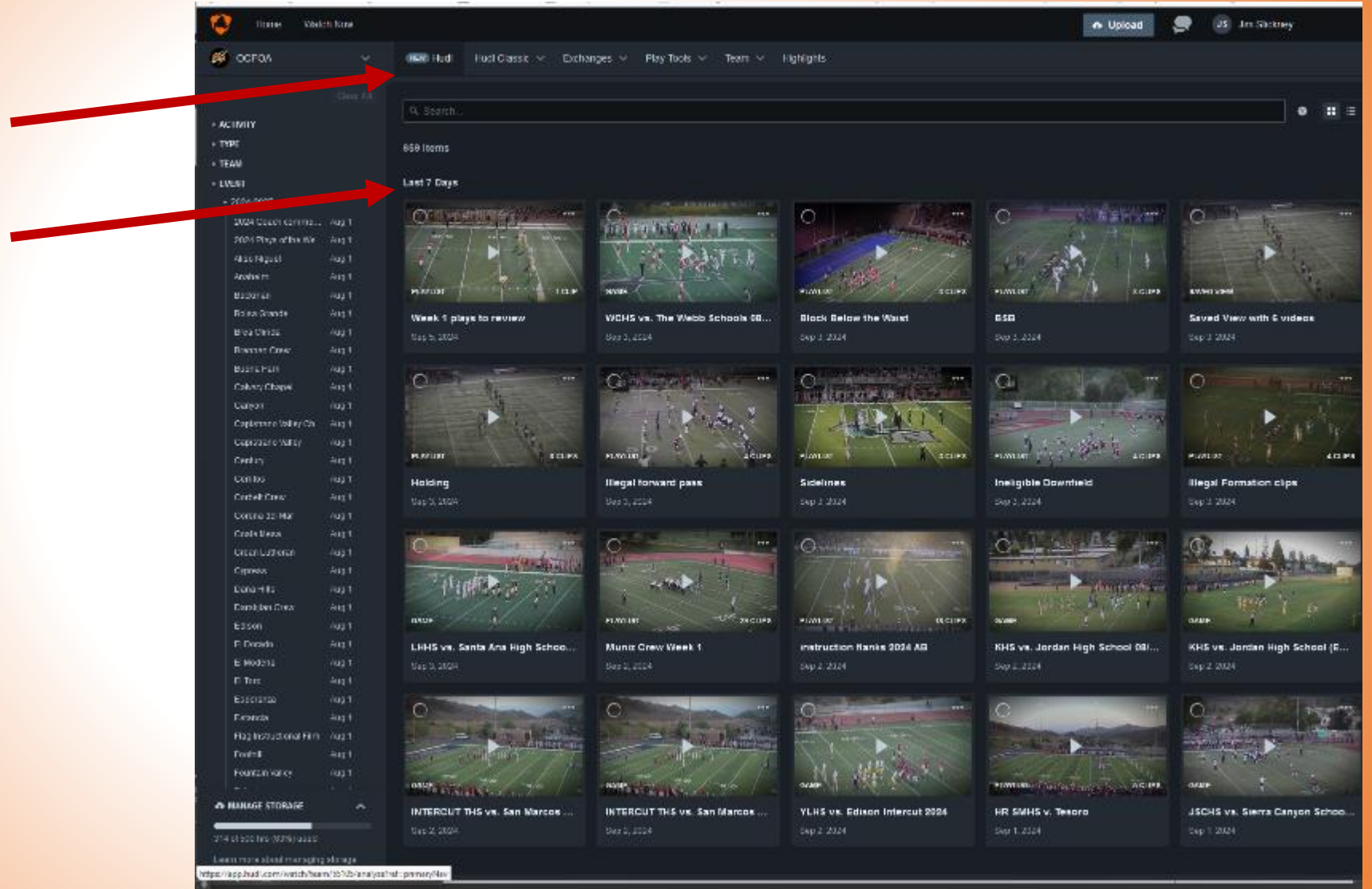
The main screen has changed in 2024.

New initial view – Last 7 days of game film and playlists shared with you or by you.

If a playlist or game was not shared with you, you will not see it.

As you scroll down you can view last 30 days of film or playlists

Next step is to go to the team folder of which game you want to view.





2024 New Hudl Game Film – select game film to review

Select folder you want to view –

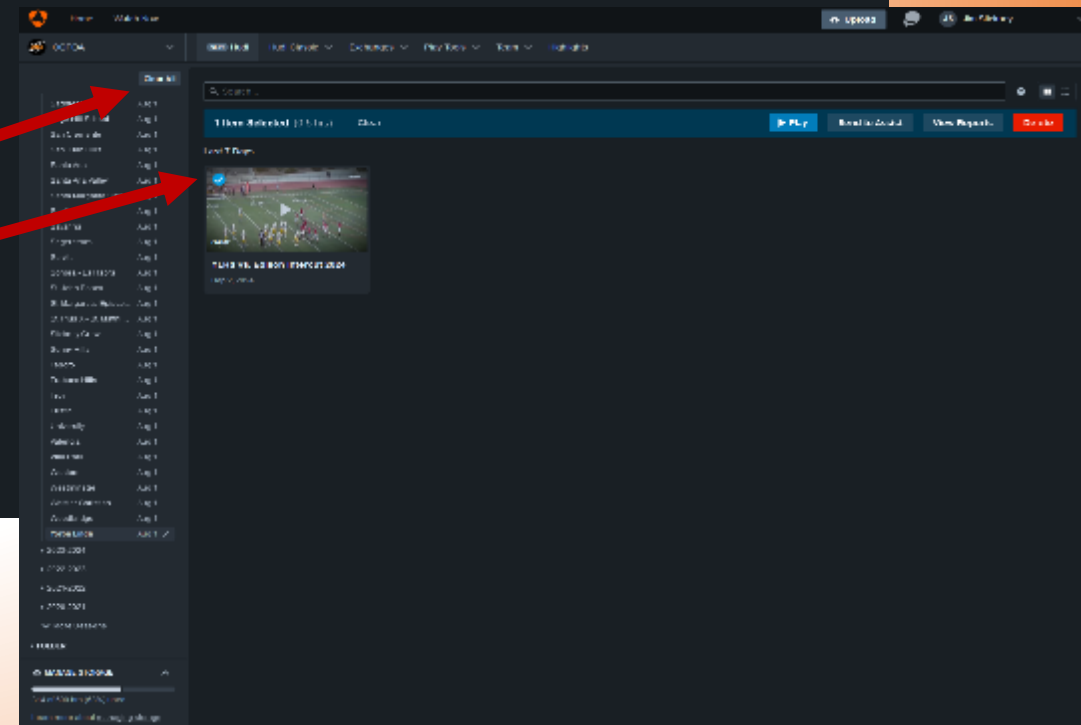
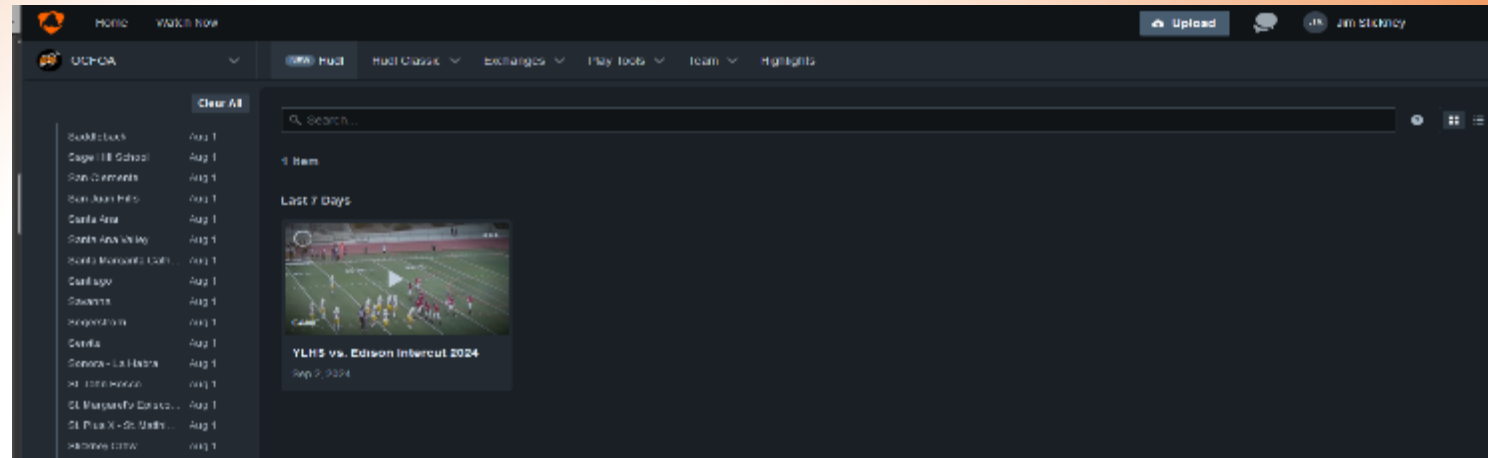
Selecting Yorba Linda

Any games shared by Yorba Linda will be loaded to this folder.

In this example, only one film loaded.

Select game film

Note: To go back to the main and view all game film, you must “clear all” or uncheck the current film.





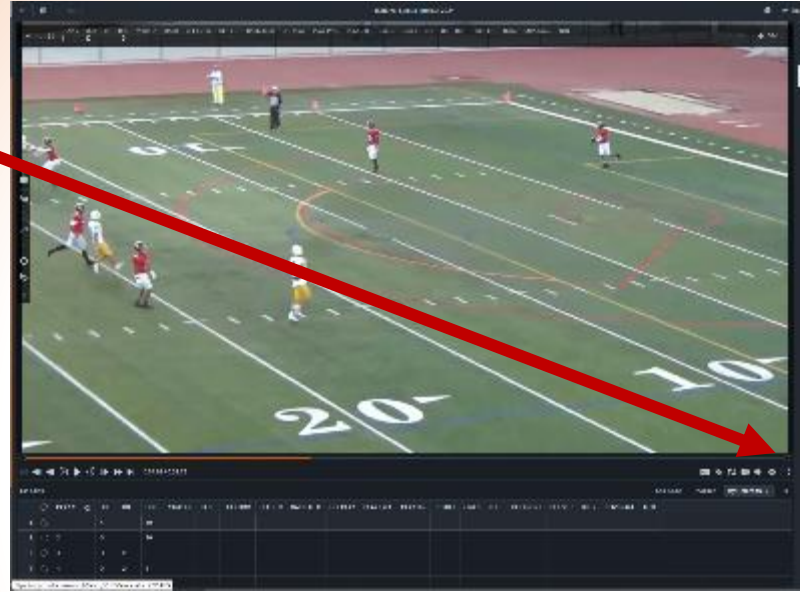
2024 New Hudl Game Film – reviewing game film

Play film – your selected film will pop up and start playing. If first time reviewing film, I recommend selecting full screen for better viewing. “Esc” to get out of full screen.

In full screen mode, you can make edits, and you can start creating your play list as you review.

Note: Any edits or comments on the main film will be viewed by all officials.

2024 New Hudl Game Film – creating playlist

Creating playlist from full screen.

As you are going through the film and you find plays that are of interest to you, select + Add.

Options:

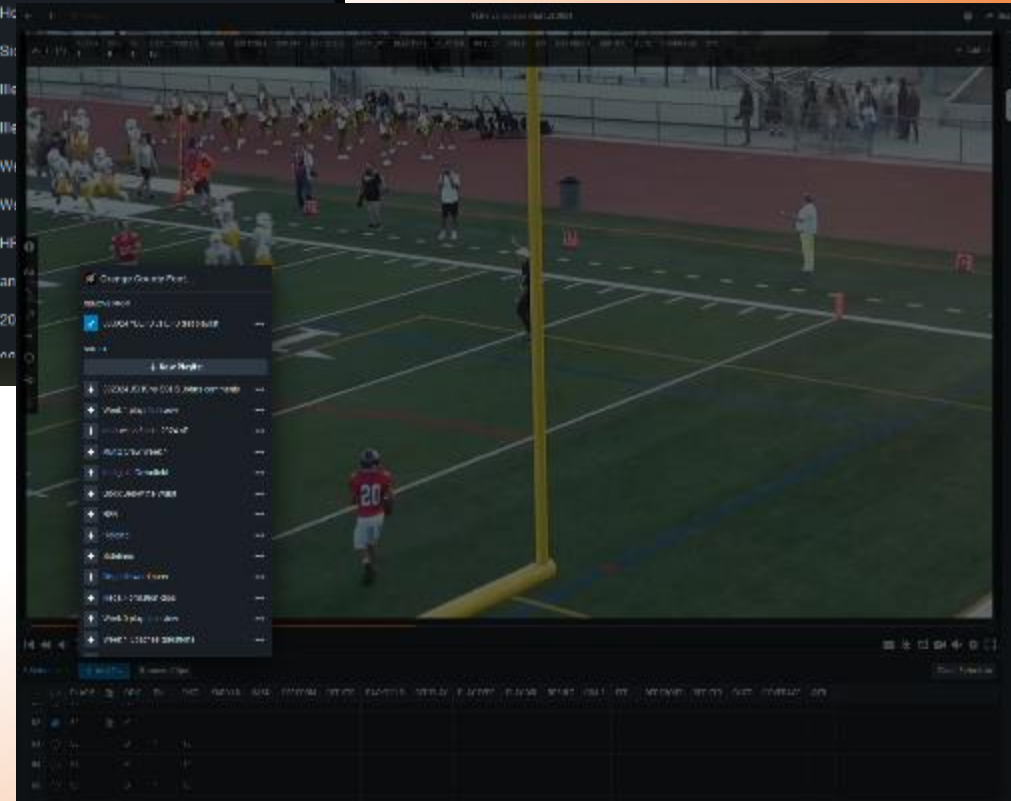
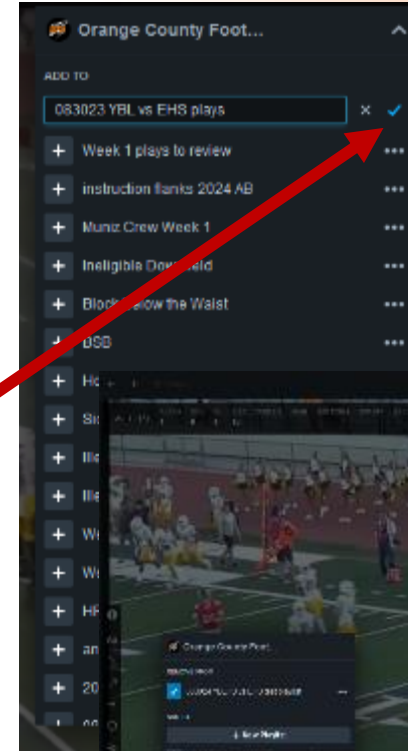
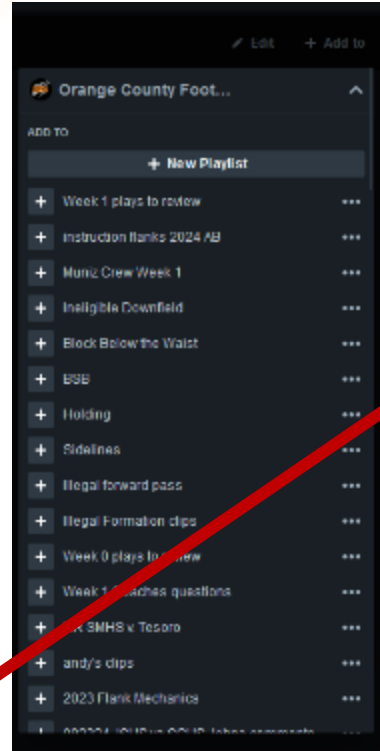
Add to an existing play list, select “+” – this is good if you want to keep similar plays together like “Ineligibles downfield”

+ New Playlist – this is good if you want to create a play list to share with your crew or others.

Recommend, starting with date of game then schools involved, but can label the playlist whatever you want.

Click the check mark when ready

As you continue through the game you can add more clips, select + Add or select play by clicking the circle on the play.





2024 New Hudl Game Film – moving playlist

Now that you have created a playlist, next steps. How to move a playlist to a folder and share.

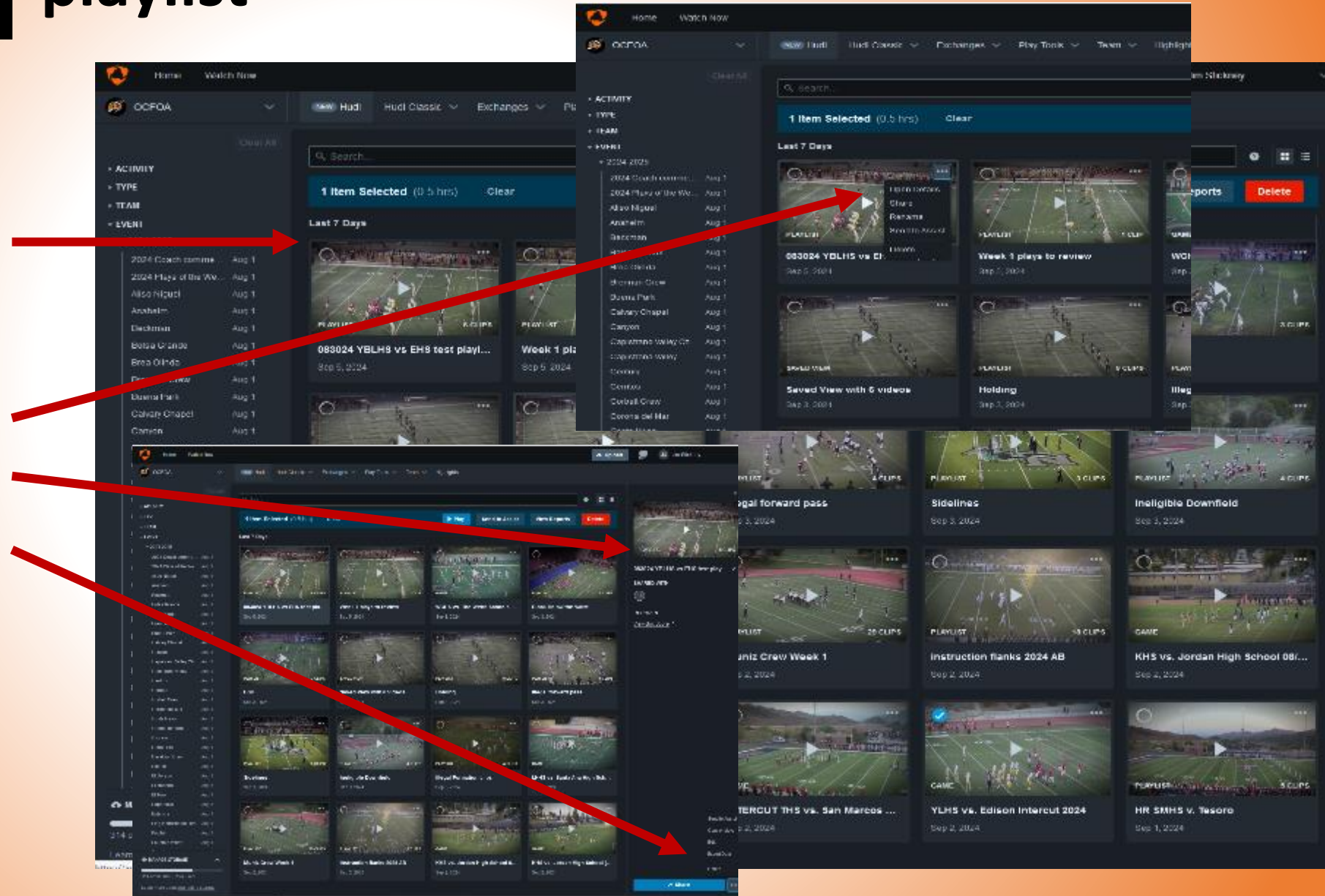
Back out of the game film to the main screen, select clear all. Your playlist should show up. If it doesn't refresh your screen.

Moving playlist –

Select 3(...) dots then select “open details”

Select 3 (...) dots again then select “Copy or Move”

New window will open (see next slide)





2024 New Hudl Game Film – moving playlist

After selecting “Copy or Move” from the details

New window will open (see next slide)

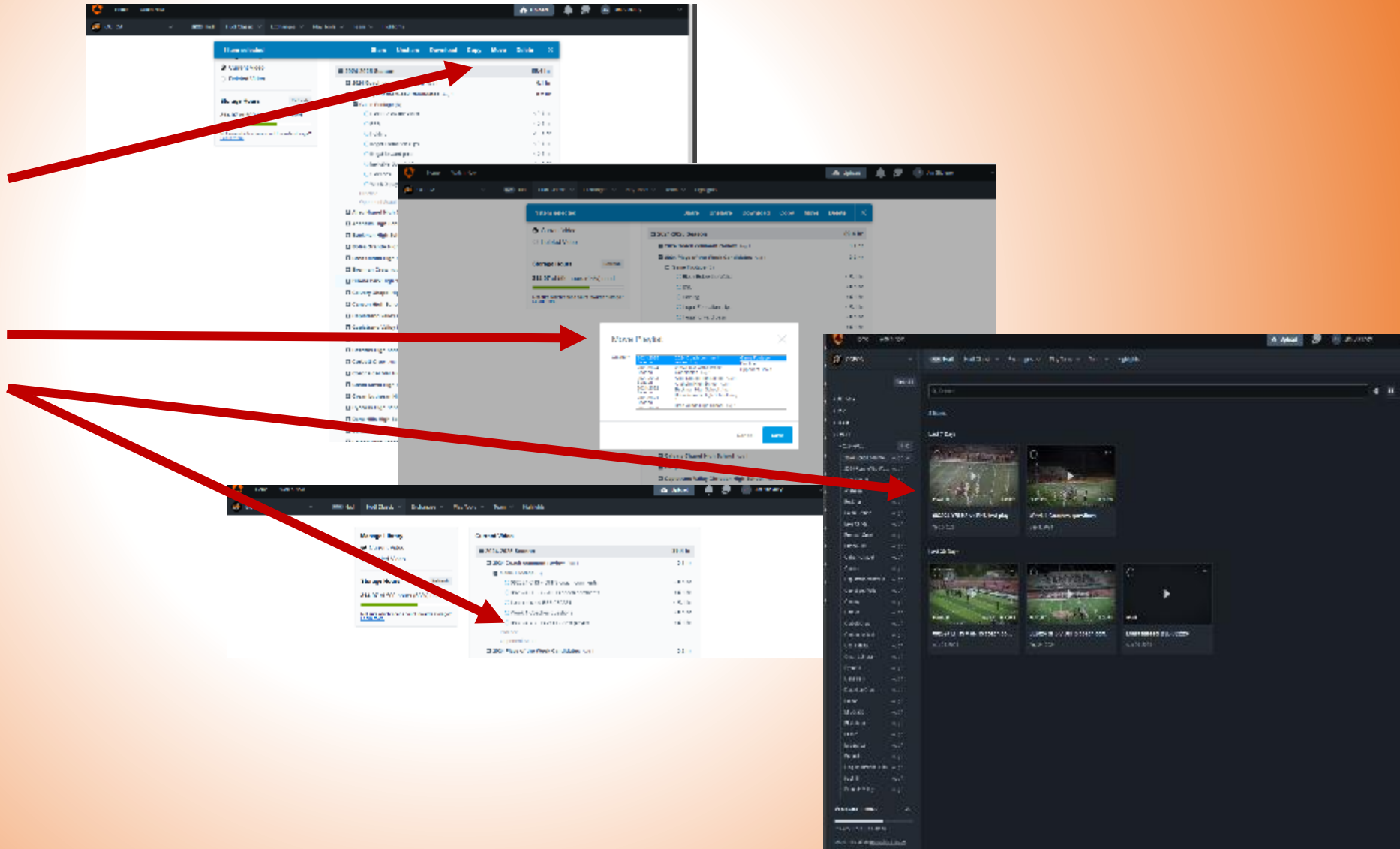
Select your option, copy or move

Pop up window to select folder you want to move film: example “2024 Coach comment review” and “Game footage”

Select save

You should see in Last 7 days and folder now.

2024 New Hudl Game Film – sharing playlist

Next step to share

Select 3 dots and “share”

Pop up with drop down

Select who you want to share with

Add any comments

Then share playlist

Note:

All film received from schools is shared with “Tackle Only” and “Tackle/Flag” officials distribution list.

When sharing, make sure “Tackle” and “Tackle/Flag” are not selected.

Example of adding effects to play

Step 1 – Select “Navigate”, this will show your clips.

Step 2 - Select effects on the left side of the screen to add comments and/or arrows, circles or other effects.

Note: Effects can be turned off by clicking the playback icon (next to the speaker icon), then selecting “effects”

Adding description of play

After editing play:

Step 1 – In navigation list, click on pencil icon in the clip field
